

Ramil Rashitovich KHASANSHIN was born in Tashkent in 1960 where he received a classical art education. He graduated from the Tashkent Art Institute in 1988 with a specialty in "Graphic Design." Since then he has taught painting, drawing and composition at the Republican Art College.

"Among artists he was well known in the 80's and 90's as a talented graphic artist and a very perceptive drawer. If you look at his portraits and landscapes, which are made in techniques of water-colour, pastel, and oils, you can see how talented this artist is. He is always outstanding in his taste and feeling of colour and materials." Says Kidisuk Natalia Georgievna, General Director of Katris.

In New London, KHASANSHIN painted "enpleinair" in the bitter cold of January in New England, along with his friend and fellow artist from Tashkent, Madkhiddin Umarovich RAFIKOVICH. His landscapes refelect the dreary, cold, grey of the season expressed with a full palette of warm and cold tones and values with a mastery of his handling of oils.
